

THE CURATOR OF THE MUSEUM.

About February last you kindly supplied me with a small collection of native weapons for Dr. Haden Guest of the Empire Parliamentary Association.

I am now in receipt of a communication from Dr. Guest, in which he states that some of the weapons were numbered, and asking if the numbers referred to any catalogue or book to which he could obtain access. I take it the numbers were the exhibit numbers, but if you could let me know the names of the implements which were supplied in this collection I should be very glad to have the information.

While on the subject of native weapons, I recently arranged for a very considerable quantity of weapons collected from the natives in the vicinity of our Avon Valley Station to be secured and forwarded here, and when received I shall have them sent up to the Museum. These weapons include stone axe heads, etc., and constitute a fine collection.
